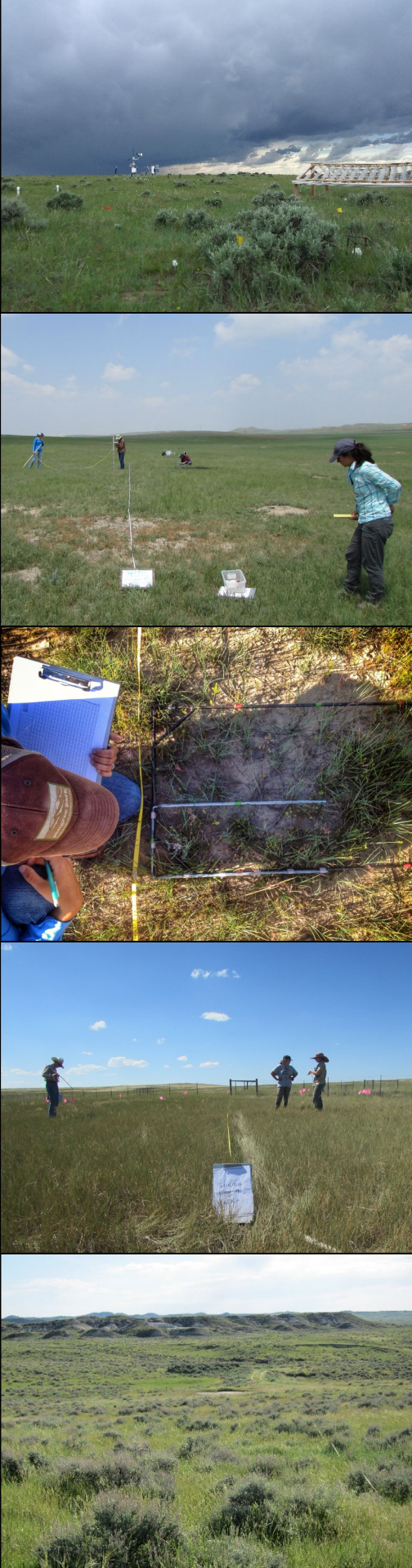




# Hiring: Rangeland Ecology Research Assistant
