

Internship Opportunity!!!

Project: Off-highway vehicle impacts on wildlife and livestock on public rangelands in northern Arizona



Who can apply: SNRE undergraduates either enrolled for 3 credits over the summer OR 6 credits in both Spring 2025 and Fall 2025, interested in getting experience with public land management and working with stakeholders. It's OK if you have limited previous field experience!

Where: Mix of virtual and USFS Red Rocks Ranger District near **Sedona, AZ**. Field Lodging and funds are provided to travel to and from Sedona.

When: Approximately June 15 – August 15 (some flexibility in timing!)

What: Road surveys for Off-highway vehicles, game camera management, bird surveys, social surveys, and data management

Why: Off-roading is a valued past-time in Arizona, but can come into conflict with other land management goals like wildlife or livestock.

Pay rate: \$14.50/hr
