

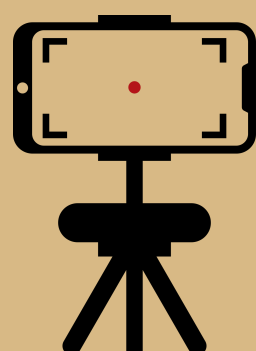


IYRP 2026 WORLD CUP VIDEO STORIES

FILM WITH YOUR PHONE

- Use a tripod, if possible, or prop phone on a stable surface to avoid shaky footage. Submission might be disqualified if video is shaky.
- Film in landscape (horizontal), NOT in portrait (vertical).
- **Tip:** Use items (such water bottles) to mark frame sides.

TIMING

- Video must be 10 seconds (s) maximum
 - Start recording 2s before soccer ball enters frame.
 - Stop recording 2s after soccer ball leaves frame.
- **Tip:** Avoid filming between 10am to 2pm to avoid harsh light.

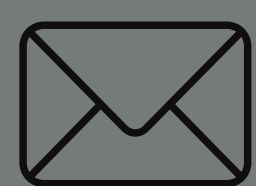

DIRECTION

- Soccer ball has to enter the frame from the left and leave it on the right. Other movement will NOT be accepted. See the figure below.
- **Tip:** No close ups please. Player(s) must be in the frame.

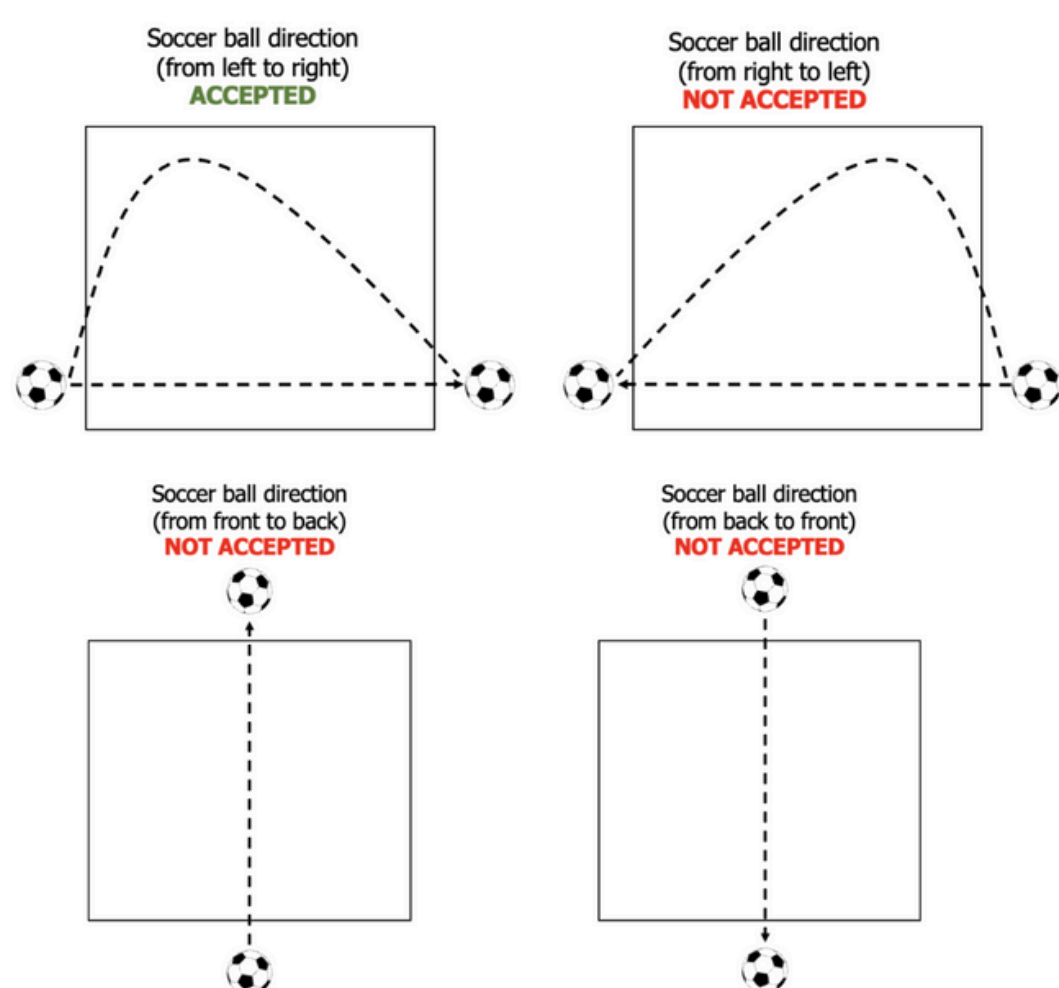
